## Clintonville Area Commission Announces 2021 Election Process

The Clintonville Area Commission (CAC) approved a 2021 election timeline at their February meeting proposed by the CAC Election Committee.

While the 2020 election took place exclusively through a mail-in ballot process during the first few months of the COVID-19 pandemic, the 2021 election will provide voters the opportunity to vote safely via mail or in-person at an outdoor, socially-distanced station at Whetstone Library.

The full timeline is attached on page two. Key dates for candidates and voters include:

Saturday, February 20 – Candidate Petitions available at Whetstone Library
Saturday, March 27 – Deadline for Submission of Candidate Petitions
Friday, April 2 – Deadline to Notify Election Committee of Write-in Candidacy
Monday, April 12 – Deadline for Receipt of Mail-in Ballot Request Forms
Tuesday, April 27 – Early Voting Day, 6-8 PM near Whetstone Community Center
Friday, April 30 – Deadline Mail-in Ballot Requests
Saturday, May 1 – Election Day near Whetstone Community Center
