7:08 p.m. Community Update - Isom Nivins

- Area Commission Agreements: City is contemplating giving area commissions the \$2,500 up front.
- Make up Area Commissions Training
 - City is in process of coordinating for date in June
- Westley Glen Update: Drains have worked and are making a difference in flooding
- Staff Member at OLP Concerns expressed to Isom:
 - Cross walk that terminates at E. Dominion Blvd allows water to pool resulting in "negative pedestrian experience".

 - 1) Graphics Variance 4330 and 4340 North High Street
 - a. City Code Section 3377.20(A)
 - b. Request is for a sign to be placed above the two tenant spaces to match the existing signs along front of the Dr. Kvitko Center strip; to allow sign on wall that does not enclose use.
 - c. Z & V passed 5-0
 - d. Applicant gave a brief description.
 - 2) BZA17-041: Johnnie Coffee, LLC, 12 W. Pacemont
 - a. City Code Section 3312.49.a reduction in parking from five spaces to zero (reduction required because the proposed use is as a non-chain coffee shop).
 - b. Z & V passed 5-0, with contingency of use remaining a coffee shop.
 - c. Applicants presented information on how they've been working with neighboring business owners to lease parking spaces. Open times will be 7:00am to 4:00pm. Expect approximately 10-15 seats.

- 7:40 p.m. Planning & Development: Discussion of Median Sponsorship Commissioner Wetherholt
 - There have been issues/concerns over liability with sponsorship. Studio 35 has offered to take care of the one on Indianola.
 - Construction is set to begin this year pending approval; the project also includes cross walks in other areas of Clintonville
 - Commissioner Wetherholt said there might be interest in forming a "Friends of the Median" group.
 - Any sponsor would be responsible for maintenance and some costs.
 - Commissioner Wetherholt opened up the floor for questions:
 - Commissioner Vottero asked about whether the CAC would be able to review the design and had concerns over signage.
 - After discussion, Commissioner Wetherholt proposed that the issue be tabled and asked that Commissioners provide comments and concerns to the Infrastructure Agreement the city requires for these by early next week.
